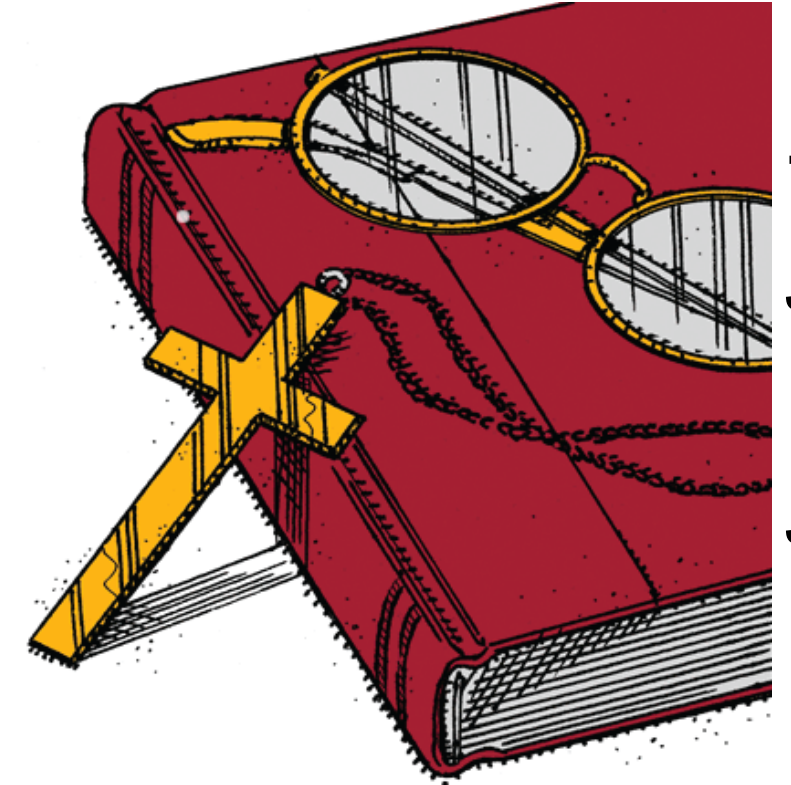

Joe Donaho, Senior Minister from
1988 - 2000 (Here Feb. 21 - 22)



Joe Donaho, born in Bryan, Texas received his undergraduate degree from Texas Christian University in Fort Worth, his Master of Divinity from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary, and his Doctorate from McCormick Theological Seminary. Under Dr. Donaho's leadership, Eastminster grew to 2,000-plus members, and the Christian Education building and the Christian Life Center were built. Eastminster's sixth senior minister, Joe Donaho, and his wife, Kay, retired to Memphis, TN. Retirement was busy for Joe, as he served as an interim senior pastor at both Woodland United Presbyterian Church and Germantown Presbyterian Church. In the fall of 2009 he retired again.

Paul Eckel, Senior Minister from
1973 - 1976 (Here Wed. March 3)



Paul Eckel was born in Kobe, Japan and received his undergraduate degree from the University of Maryland and a Bachelor of Divinity from Princeton Seminary. He and his wife Madilyn have two children. When he was a pastor at Eastminster, there were 1,283 members, and Eastminster elected its first women elders, Virginia Odom and Edith Strasburger. Dr. Eckel later served as Senior Pastor of First Presbyterian Church in Atlanta, GA and with Renewal Ministries Foundation. Paul is currently the interim minister at Northminster Presbyterian Church in Sarasota, Florida.

Ernest Thompson, Senior Minister
from 1977 - 1986 (Here March 8-9)



Ernest Thompson, Jr., earned his Bachelor of Divinity degree from Union Theological Seminary and Doctorate from McCormick Theological Seminary. He is the son of a pastor, and he and his wife, Jackie, have four children. During his time at Eastminster, the church experienced a net gain of 500 members; the fellowship hall (Thompson Hall) was dedicated; and additional classrooms were added. In addition, Eastminster began its first comprehensive officer training course; the hand bell choir began to ring; and the church gave strong leadership in establishing a new Presbyterian Home in the Columbia area.
